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| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• NEO will follow the approved 2020-2021 school year calendar• Students who need to stay home due to illness or exposure will have access to remote instruction• Teachers will continue to provide quality instruction and meaningful learning experiences• Support staff will continue to offer assistance including attendance monitoring, mental health, and special education services• Soap and hand sanitizer available throughout the building and in each classroom• Routine cleaning and disinfecting is performed regularly on a high frequency scheduled basis by custodial staff; routine daily cleaning and disinfecting includes all restrooms, classrooms, floors, sanitizing of cafeteria tables, emptying trash, etc. | | |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will attend school daily according to the traditional schedule.• Masks may or may not be required depending on guidance of health officials. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• High school students will attend school on their assigned days (twice a week). Adult education students will attend at assigned times provided by their teacher. When not in the building, ALL students will do distance learning at home.• Masks are to be worn by staff and students at all times when social distancing of 6 feet or more is not possible, when eating, and/or at teacher discretion in the classroom.• Partner and group work will be limited• Materials are not to be shared by students and classroom materials will be disinfected between uses• Individual devices will be assigned to each student and disinfected after each use. High school students will receive a device to take home as needed.• Floors will be marked to space students in lunch line or waiting to enter bathrooms or classrooms• All food will be individually wrapped – not offered or served family style. No self-serve service options will be available. Continued use of disposable plates and utensils at lunch• NEO Adult Ed students will be permitted to bring snacks, but will not be allowed to participate in the NNVHS lunch program. | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will complete all of their learning remotely using Google classroom and other learning platforms• High school students will receive a Chromebook to utilize at home if needed• NEO will communicate with parents and students about meal needs and regional food resources• When requested, high school students will receive a week’s worth of meals at a weekly, scheduled pick up• Adult education students will be required to log on to their classes at scheduled times and will have homework outside of the scheduled class time |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All staff and students will self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms daily before coming to school• Student seating will be assigned and arranged to provide 6’ distance between students• Students must wash hands prior meals; food should not be shared• Cafeteria is cleaned between each meal service and chairs are placed to socially distance during lunch | | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• NEO will provide timely IT support for staff and students• Teachers will focus instruction on priority standards and utilize competency-based assessments• Assignments and grading schedules will be modified as needed• Teachers will provide asynchronous and synchronous instruction and learning opportunities, including recorded lessons for online access and review and utilize strategies like flipped learning to deliver direct instruction• High school teachers will maintain daily “office hours” when they will be available to students and parents on an appointment basis |
